**Approval by mail: Cambodia: Climate Resilient Rural Infrastructure in Kampong Cham Province (as part of the Cambodia: Rural Roads Improvement Project II) (PPCR) (ADB) —Approval Notification**

**Dear PPCR Sub-Committee members,**

We are writing regarding the project entitled, *Cambodia: Climate Resilient Rural Infrastructure in Kampong Cham Province (as part of the Cambodia: Rural Roads Improvement Project II)*, submitted by the Asian Development Bank (ADB) for your review and approval of a PPCR funding of USD 16.0 million (USD 7.0 million in concessional loans, USD 9.0 million in grants), and USD 390,000 for project implementation and supervision services.

The time period provided for submission of comments and any objections to the decision has now expired. We are, therefore, pleased to inform you that the following decision is approved:
