



3rd ASEAN COUNTRIES PUBLIC PROCUREMENT KNOWLEDGE EXCHANGE FORUM (APPKE), OCTOBER 24 – 25, 2018, BALI, INDONESIA

Overview

The theme for the 3rd APPKE Forum, "Improving Effectiveness of Public Procurement Through Data Analytics " is being held in Bali, Indonesia from October 24 – 25, 2018. and hosted by The World Bank in collaboration with LKPP-the National Public Procurement Agency of Indonesia.

The Forum serves as a platform for bringing together senior procurement officials of ASEAN member countries and establishing a functional mechanism for knowledge sharing, cooperation and harmonization, aimed at strengthening public procurement within and across the ASEAN member countries.

Senior government officials responsible for public procurement policies and oversight from ASEAN member countries will participate and also make presentations on the current procurement monitoring and evaluation system and future plans in their respective countries. Representatives from Development Partner Organizations working in ASEAN countries will also participate and share their experiences. A number of expert speakers will present latest developments and highlight the transformational impact of data analytics in enabling effective public procurement. There will also be panel discussions to drill down on specific related sub-topics.

	<p>Room charges Payment:</p> <p>World Bank sponsored participants - For the Government Delegates from ASEAN member countries and the expert speakers who are being sponsored by the World Bank and have already been informed accordingly, their hotel room charges will be paid directly by the World Bank to the hotel.</p> <p>Self-sponsored participants - All remaining participants who are self-sponsored should please settle their hotel bills themselves directly with the hotel upon check out.</p> <p>Kindly note that personal charges (laundry, phone calls, minibar, etc.) for any participant (including World Bank sponsored participants) are not covered by the World Bank and all such expenses will be borne and settled directly by the participants with the hotel.</p> <p>Ground Transportation: Upon arrival to the Ngurah Rai International Airport, we recommend you take a public taxi. The taxi counter is located next to the information desk after you walk through the little “Dufy” shopping arcade for the International arrival terminal. And for the domestic arrival terminal, the taxi counter located just in the exit the arrival building. Please prepare to have Indonesia currency for the payment. You can exchange for Indonesia currency at the arrival hall. Ngurah Rai international airport terminal is approximately 11 kilometers (7 miles) north western, half an hour from the Seminyak area/Courtyard by Marriot Hotel, depending on traffic and time of day. The cost of regular taxi to the event’s hotel should not be more than IDR 250,000 (equal to USD 16.44).</p> <p>Meals Breakfast is provided as part of the room charge paid by the World Bank. Currency	The official currency used for transaction of business in Indonesia is “Rupiah (IDR)”. Currency may be exchanged at the airport, in the hotel, at the Banks or exchange bureaus. The current exchange rates are approximately: USD 1 = IDR 15,200.
The Weather	The daily average temperature for Bali in October is usually around 30°C. Though this time is dry periods, there is still a low chance of a shower. In October, the sun normally shines for 8 hours per day, with temperatures generally settling between 24°C and 31°C
Electrical voltage and plug	Voltage is at 220 V 50 Hz. Plugs and Sockets in Indonesia is the 2 pins socket and plug as used in larger parts of Europe. The pins are round, not flat or rectangular.
