



Consultant(s) – Expression of Interest

The World Bank invites potential candidates to express their interests to work as short-term consultants on the World Bank program in Croatia.

Positions to be offered may require assignment in the period of August 2018-January 2019. Availability in Zagreb is required.

The Consultant(s) will assist a team of World Bank economists in analytical work on Croatian legislation and business practices in a range of markets - in particular, construction, engineering and architecture services. The Consultant(s) may be asked to hold interviews with the representatives of the Croatian state administration bodies and/or professional organizations.

The qualifications of the potential candidates shall include:

- 1) A post-secondary degree in engineering or architecture or
At least three years of experience in providing engineering or architecture services in Croatia;
- 2) Excellent analytical, interviewing and critical thinking skills;
- 3) Native mastery of Croatian and excellent command of written and spoken English;
- 4) Proficiency in MS Office.

The following shall be considered an asset:

- 5) Knowledge of construction and engineering regulation in Croatia;
- 6) Demonstrated international experience;
- 7) More than three and up to ten years of experience in providing engineering or architecture services in Croatia.

Applications of senior candidates with more significant experience in providing engineering or architecture services in Croatia are also encouraged and the remuneration of such candidates will be aligned with their qualifications and experience.

The services of the Consultant(s) may be required for 20-50 days until January 31, 2019. The Consultant(s) can perform the above duties while continuing her or his current employment in conjunction with other work provided that he/she is not a government employee and that there is no conflict of interest.

Selected candidates will be invited to an interview of up to 60 minutes. The interview will consist of an evaluation of the candidate's experience and a role-playing exercise to examine interviewing and critical thinking skills.
