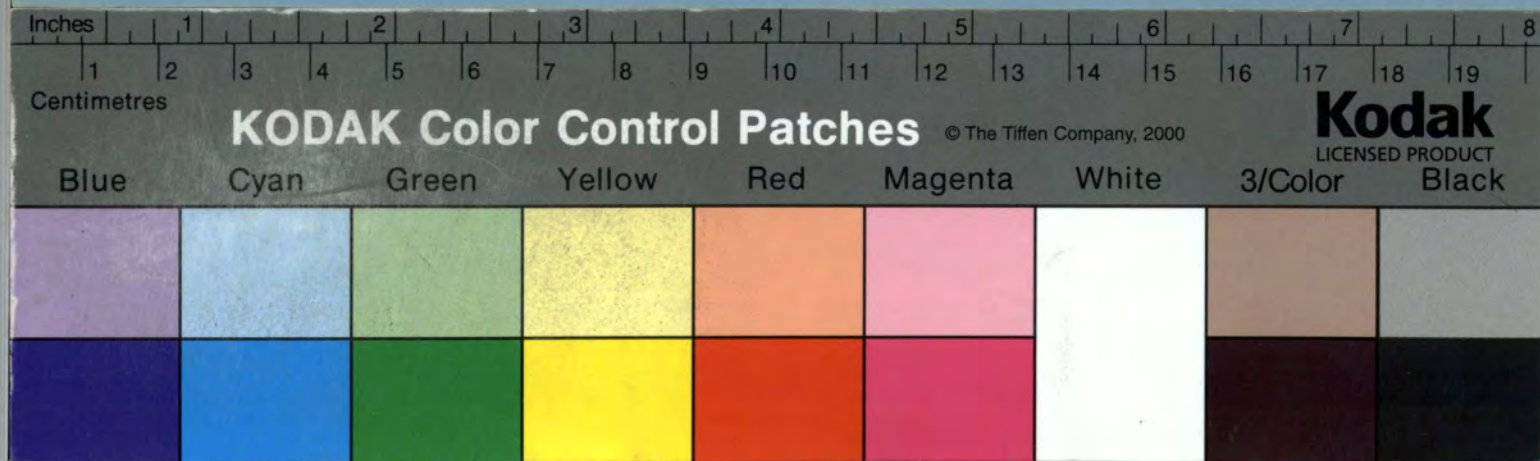

CR-304-ET-1 On May 4, 1972, the International Development Association (IDA) has approved a credit for the equivalent of \$11 million to the Empire of Ethiopia to cover the import component of the lending and investment program of the Agricultural and Industrial Development Bank (AIDB) and to finance consultants to assist in the preparation of a national agricultural credit program.
