

SilverScript Employer PDP sponsored by World Bank Group (SilverScript)

Effective **January 1, 2016**, all Medicare-eligible retirees, their covered Medicare-eligible spouses/domestic partners and/or covered Medicare-eligible children participating in the World Bank Group Retiree Medical Insurance Plan (RMIP) will have a new prescription drug plan called **SilverScript Employer PDP sponsored by World Bank Group (SilverScript)**. “Employer PDP” means that SilverScript is an employer-provided Medicare Part D prescription drug plan. All eligible members will be automatically enrolled by the Bank Group.
