Nutrition

We are finally beginning to get up some momentum in nutrition in this Department, helped in no small measure by Alan, Rae, Judy and Phil, as well as Jim Greene, who all very kindly joined a departmental brainstormer on Nutrition last week, organized at the request of Francis Colaco. We caucused afterward and are choosing to get to work on identifying and preparing a nutrition project in Kenya where we have reason to think our chances are the best. Although I realize this is late in terms of the current cross-support exercise, I am writing to request about 10 staffweeks of Rae Galloway's and about 5 staff weeks of Judy McGuire's time next FY to assist us in this effort.

WDR Tryout

Let me hasten to add that we are also looking forward to your agreeing to the on-going discussions between Phil Musgrove, Tony Meacham and this Division about the possibility that Phil and others of the WDR team select Kenya as a country site in which to test out some of the main ideas of the WDR, especially analyzing the national burden of disease and the cost effectiveness of health interventions. We are confident that exercise will yield results of use throughout the Bank.

WDR Rollout

Finally, I hope very much you can participate as a session Moderator on Monday June 7th, in the forthcoming WDR Workshop we are organizing for strong delegations from Kenya, Uganda and Tanzania (at least). I am sure the delegations would like to meet you and that you will enjoy the occasion. Charlie Griffin, the Workshop Organizer sent you an invitation last Thursday or Friday.
