

CR-850-EGT The INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATION (IDA), an affiliate of the WORLD BANK, has approved a \$25 million credit for a second population project in the Arab Republic of Egypt. The \$60.3 million project will improve provision of family planning and maternal and child health services, and encourage an expanded use of such services, concentrating particularly on the Governorates of Giza, Qalubia, Qena, Minya, El-Wadi El-Gedid, Kafr-El-Sheikh, and two districts of Cairo Governorate. An \$8 million grant for the project is expected to be made by the Ministry of Overseas Development of the United Kingdom. (Refer to IDA News Release No. 79/15)
