Streamlining MRV for GHG emissions across sectors

GRANT OBJECTIVE AND ACTIVITIES

The project will support the government of Burkina Faso, a member of the NDC Partnership, to improve its institutional framework to foster private investment in GHG mitigating activities and meet the country's NDC targets. The project will have three main components. First, it will set-up a crediting framework to facilitate the creation of carbon credits in Burkina Faso, including a central registry of carbon operations and accounting rules. Additionally, the project will improve the MRV system to oversee all Agriculture, Forestry, and Other Land Use (AFLOU) operations through a single system that also covers REDD+ and Climate Smart Agriculture operations. Finally, the project will assist Burkina Faso to build capacity and knowledge for participating in international negotiations, especially those pertaining to Article 6 of the Paris Agreement.
