CR-571-CK-1 An IDA credit of \$26 million equivalent will assist Zaire in the improvement and expansion of its river/rail transport system, known as the "Voie Nationale".

The project is designed principally to expand the capacity and efficiency of the Office National des Transports (ONATRA), the National Transport Authority. The IDA Credit will finance a major part of ONATRA's 1975-77 investment requirements for river transport equipment, railroad improvements and track renewal, and furnish it with technical assistance and a staff training program. It also provides for port and railway studies for the Government, a buoy tender for the Regie des Voies Fluviales and rehabilitation of navigational markings under the jurisdiction of that agency.
