### **KEY RESULTS OF THE COMPONENT:**

Two MA programs were established in two Russian universities and being sustainably implemented

The programs are fully operational.

National Research University – Higher
School of Economics (Moscow)
developed and delivers full-time MA
program "Educational and
Psychological Measurement". Moscow
School for Social and Economic
Sciences developed and delivers
part-time MA program "Educational
Evaluation and Assessment".

PhD program and exported program are created and being delivered in two Russian universities

Higher School of Economics scaled up the program on educational measurements and evaluations and now delivers the PhD program on its basis. The competitive selection also identified the Moscow City University as an institution to export the MA program on education quality to another country. Currently, the university is working closely with the university of Abai in Kazakhstan.

#### Russian Training Center on Education Policy in CIS and ECA countries was established and sustained

RTC became fully operational and currently provides short-term training to policymakers and specialists in the area of education quality assurance. Beginning from May 2011 RTC has delivered 8 learning courses, 5 seminars and 15 webinars. More than 9500 participants took part in whose events, including 7500 from the Russian Federation and almost 2000 from 8 CIS countries (Azerbaijan, Armenia, Belarus Republic, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyz Republic, Moldova, Taiikistan, and Turkmenistan), 473 specialists participated in the face-to-face format and 9100 distantly. Under READ 2 RAS the RTC has changed the institutional home and moved to Moscow School of Social and Economic sciences, however the capacity was saved and continues to be used. Currently, the RTC has delivered different types of training programs to more than 1,500 participants.
