## MODULE B: INSTRUCTIONS

<b>B00</b>	If there are more than 10 people living in this residence, then use a second questionnaire form to complete the listing and interview. In that case mark the designated box in Module L question L02 with an ‘X’ on both questionnaire forms and complete question L03: “Form ___ of ___ forms in total” information on each questionnaire form. Start Module B of the second form on the first line with the 11 <sup>th</sup> person living in the residence (i.e., on the second form, do not repeat the respondent info collected on the first form).
<b>B01</b>	Fill in first names of the persons living in this residence starting with the respondent. This is optional. First names are collected to facilitate the interview process and correct completion of the questionnaire. If the respondent refuses to provide first names, enter “person A” for the respondent and the next respective letter in the alphabet for each subsequent household member.
<b>B03</b>	If “08 = other relative” or “09 = non-relative”, prompt for specifics describing the relationship and use the comment section below to record details. For example, “my cousin” or “my friend” or “fellow student” etc.
<b>B06</b>	If “03 = other”, use the comments section below to record country name. <i>Data entry note: use the ISO-3166 3-digit numerical coding system.</i>
<b>B07</b>	Show map of Senegal and ask respondent to point out the State name. 1 = Abia; 2 = Adamawa ; 3 = Akwa Ibom ; 4 = Anambra ; 5 = Bauchi; 6 =Bayelsa; 7 = Benue; 8 = Borno ; 9= Cross River; 10= Delta ; 11= Ebonyi ; 12 = Edo ; 13= Ekiti ; 14= Enugu; 15 =Federal Capital Territory; 16= Gombe; 17= Imo; 18= Jigawa; 19 = Kaduna ; 20 = Kano ; 21 =Katsina; 22 = Kebbi ; 23 = Kogi ; 24 = Kwara; 25 = Lagos; 26 =Nassarawa; 27 = Niger ; 28 = Ogun ; 29 =Ondo ; 30 =Osun ; 31 = Oyo ; 32 = Plateau ; 33= Rivers ; 34 =Sokoto ; 35 =Taraba ; 36 = Yobe ; 37 = Zamfara

<b>B10</b>	Under “7 = other”, particularly prompt the respondent for non-university level post-secondary education. For instance, technical schooling such as degrees in nursing, mechanics, business administration, etc.
<b>B12</b>	“Main” activity is defined as that in which the respondent spend the most hours. Prompt respondents to see if they both study and work. In that case, mark B12 = 3 and in questions B13 and B14 record the occupation and sector in which the student worked. Most hours criteria also applies to “main” occupation in B13.
<b>B15</b>	“Net” income is defined net of taxes and social security payments, if applicable. In other words, the earnings available for spending. This also applies to B16.

## MODULE C: INSTRUCTIONS

- C02** A household in Senegal is defined as a group of people who live together and share meals together.  
*If there are more than 5 different sender-recipient pairs, then use an additional questionnaire form to complete the interview and mark the designated box in Module L question L02 with an 'X' on both questionnaire forms and complete question L03. Identify the correct number of SEPARATE SENDERS.*  
 When two or more people send money together (i.e., both are contributing in cash to the transaction) then prompt for more specific information to identify correct number of people. For instance, if husband and wife both work and together (both contribute cash for the same transactions) send money to the same person in Senegal, then consider them jointly as constituting “one person” and record as senders’ ID the person who handles the actual transaction (i.e., the person who makes the transfer arrangements, such as going to an exchange or transfer bureau, etc.). Please record in detail any ambiguities or issues arising in the comments section below.  
 If more than one sender, first record all separate sender ID’s in consecutive order in C04.
- C05** If a person sends money to more than one person in Senegal, then enter that senders’ ID in C04 below last senders’ ID recorded during C02. Note that a “person in Senegal” can be more than one individual if these constitute a household that could jointly benefit from the money sent. For instance, if a husband, wife and their children in Senegal live together and regularly eat meals together, then they are to be considered as a single recipient. If more than 5 rows are needed, then use an additional questionnaire form to complete the interview and mark the designated box in Module L question L02 with an ‘X’ on both questionnaire forms and complete question L03.
