LO-1491-CR The WORLD BANK has made a \$16.5 million loan to Costa Rica to help finance an urban project. The project's main objective will be achieved primarily through the upgrading of existing transport infrastructure. This will be accomplished by the construction, widening and rehabilitation of selected existing radial roads leading into the San Jose central business district.
