EEC-37-CRG The WORLD BANK, its soft-loan affiliate, the INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATION (IDA), and the European Economic Community (EEC) through its Special Action Account for which IDA is the Administrator, will help the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) to finance public and private sector projects in the Commonwealth Caribbean countries through a lending operation amounting to \$31 million. The WORLD BANK will provide a \$23 million loan to be re-lent by the CDB to its members in the Commonwealth Caribbean. A \$7 million IDA credit and a \$1 million EEC Special Action credit will be relent by the CDB to the governments of its member countries which belong to the East Caribbean Common Market (ECCM).
