CR-271-CK-1 On September 24, 1971, the International Development Association extended a credit of \$10 million to the Democratic Republic of the Congo for a second development finance company project. The beneficiary of the credit is the Societe Congolaise de Financement du Developpement (SOCOFIDE), the country's main private institutional source of medium and long-term finance. It will cover the foreign exchange costs of projects financed by SOCOFIDE.
