LO-1599-CR The WORLD BANK has agreed to lend the Central Bank of Costa Rica (CBCR) \$15 million for an Industrial Credit Project. The main objective of the project is to increase the amount of medium- and long-term credit to industry, thus providing more appropriate financing for industrial expansion than is presently available.
