SUBJECT: Division Staff Meeting

DATE: May 10, 1966

On Monday, May 9, a Division Staff Meeting was held at 3:45 p.m. Present were Messrs. Mejía, Fernandes, Luzny, Blondel and Loeser. The following points were discussed:

1. The report on "weekly developments". Some comments were given on it.
2. The statement of reviewing of the sub-projects presented by the Colombian financieras was clarified.  
  
Two new projects, Cement Industry and Packing Industry, presented by CF Colombiana should be examined by Mr. Loeser as soon as possible.
3. The reports of board meetings of Colombian financieras will be summarized, as usual. Mr. Fernandes will be in charge of CF Caldas and Mr. Mejía of CF Norte and CF Colombiana.
4. The effect of inflation to the Finance companies in Colombia is being studied by Mr. Luzny.
5. The monthly report of CAVENDES, BNDE and FINASA will be summarized by Mr. Blondel. He is also preparing the memos on Paraguay.
6. At 4:15 p.m. Mr. Arango took part and reported about his impressions on his recent mission. He is preparing his report on the board meetings with Caldas and CAVENDES.
7. End of the Staff Meeting at 4:30 p.m.
